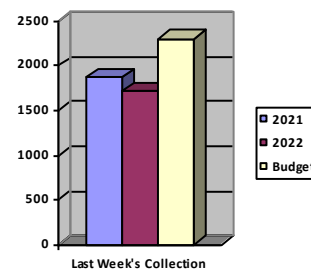

**Florence St. Vincent de Paul Society Report for July, August and September 2022**

In July: 76 families were served through St. Vincent de Paul Activities and 126 people were served from the Pantry/Commodities, 1 person was helped with rent and 9 children were helped.

In August: 74 families were served through St. Vincent de Paul Activities and 125 people were served from the Pantry/Commodities, 2 people were helped with rent and 9 children were helped.

In September: 85 families were served through St. Vincent de Paul Activities and 143 people were served from the Pantry/Commodities, 2 people were helped with rent, 2 people were help with utilities, 1 person was helped with gas vouchers and 23 children were helped.

In addition, 58 Children received shoes/school supplies, 1 family was helped with roof repairs, 1 with a bus ticket, 6 children with FFF scholarships, 1 with septic work, 2 with car seats, 1 with clothes and one with furniture from the thrift store. **Thank you St. Vincent de Paul Society!!**
