Message from the Diocese Regarding the Updated Stipend & Stole Fee: The Diocese of Green Bay and our parishes are grateful to all who have generously provided a donation for Masses, funerals, weddings, and Quinceaneras in the past. The donation for these sacraments and services has remained the same for over thirty years throughout the Dioceses of Wisconsin. Recently, when the Bishops of the state of Wisconsin gathered, they decreed that stipends should be adjusted to reflect the current time. The new stipend structure is as follows:

Mass stipend	\$20.00
Funeral Stole Fee	\$75.00
Wedding Stole Fee	\$100.00
Quinceanera Stole Fee	\$100.00

This new fee structure will become effective July 1, 2024. It will <u>not</u> be applied retroactively to those who have already paid the appropriate amount from the former fee scale. The new fee structure will be applied to all new requests received as of July 1, 2024. As always, if someone is not able to offer the stipend, the parish is always happy to provide the sacrament or service with no fee. Please know, too, that any stipend money collected goes to the parish in support of its ministry and services provided to the parish community; it does not go personally to the priest.

Friends, the Fourth Sunday of Easter is focused on Jesus, the good shepherd. This Sunday is also called Good Shepherd Sunday. Today the Diocese of Green Bay urges us to pray and promote vocations to priesthood and religious life.

In John 10:11-18, Jesus said: "I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep (He is drawing faith and trust in a shepherd who might willingly die or give his life to protect the sheep that belong to him). He who is a hireling and not a shepherd, sees the wolf coming and leaves the sheep and flees; and the wolf snatches them and scatters them. He flees because he is a hireling and cares nothing for the sheep. I am the good shepherd; I know my own and my own know me, as the Father knows me and I know the Father; and I lay down my life for the sheep (we need to affirm our children who experience that closeness and tenderness as it might be a sign of a call). And I have other sheep that are not of this fold; I must bring them also, and they will heed my voice (we need priests who go after the lost sheep). So, there shall be one flock, one shepherd. For this reason, the Father loves me, because I lay down my life, that I may take it again (the vocation is given to us because God loves us). No one takes it from me, but I lay it down of my own accord. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again; this charge I have received from my Father."

Friends, God can overcome our deficiencies if He is calling us to serve Him. Jesus says to Simon and Andrew, "Come after me, and I will make you fishers of men." This tells us something about how God acts. He is direct and in-your-face; he does the choosing. "Come after me," Jesus says. He is not offering a doctrine, a theology, or a set of beliefs. He is offering himself. It's as if he's saying, "Walk in my path; walk in imitation of me."
