Dear Friends, Our Sunday readings this week focus on themes of God's Word being accessible and effective and the imperative to love our neighbor through compassionate action. The First Reading from Deuteronomy emphasizes the proximity of God's commandments. Moses reminds the people that

the law is not something distant or unattainable, but is "something very near to you, already in your mouths and in your hearts; you have only to carry it out".

This theme is echoed in the Gospel reading from Luke, which features the well-known Parable of the Good Samaritan. A lawyer attempts to test Jesus by asking what he must do to inherit eternal life. Jesus responds by asking him to recall what is written in the law. The lawyer correctly answers, "You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your being, with all your strength, and with all your mind, and your neighbor as yourself". It is the double-love commandment. However, the lawyer, wishing to justify himself, asks, "And who is my neighbor?" Jesus then tells the story of the man who fell victim to robbers on the road from Jerusalem to Jericho. Both a priest and a Levite pass by on the other side, avoiding the injured man. It is the Samaritan, a person from a group often despised by the Jews, who shows compassion, cares for the man's wounds, and provides for his continued care at an inn.

When Jesus asks the lawyer who acted as a neighbor, he replies, "The one who treated him with mercy." Jesus tells him, "Go and do likewise". The conclusion is that applying merciful love in any situation constitutes the double-love commandment and that limited love contradicts God's double-love command. God's mercy to humanity is ultimately revealed in the sacrifice of Christ on the cross to save the wounded and robbed humanity. Jesus reconciled all things to God through his death on the cross. He is "the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation" and that "in him all things hold together".
